

WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED



Please make sure your recycling is rinsed and clean. We cannot recycle containers that are not empty.

Clothing and other used items can be dropped off at the free store.

Motor Oil and other Petroleum containers are not recyclable – Please wait for Household Hazardous Waste Day

Refundables

Aluminum Cans, Plastic, Glass, Wax/Tetra Cartons, Milk Products and Boxed Drinks



Recyclables

Steel/Tin Cans, Aluminum, Glass, Wax Cartons, Clear and Cloudy Plastic, Paper and Mixed Plastic



Composting

A municipal compost is available at the landfill and 3 locations within the city. Composting can reduce up to 50% of waste going into the landfill

Food Scraps, Tea Bags, Coffee Filters, Soiled paper products, Yard Waste, Sawdust etc.



Hazardous Waste - NON RECYCLABLES

Household Hazardous Waste Days are held Annually – Please store these items safely until they can be disposed of.

Paints, Thinners, Solvents, Cleaning Products, Pesticides, Motor Oils, Aerosol Cans, Batteries, Antifreeze, Batteries, Smoke Alarms, Fluorescent Lights
